DARIAH-CH is the national organization of the European *Digital Research Infrastructure for Arts and Humanities* DARIAH ERIC. Since January 2021, DARIAH-CH is officially an observer member and includes the Universities of Basel, Berne, Geneva, Lausanne, Neuchâtel, and Zurich, the Università della Svizzera italiana (USI), the EPFL, and the SAGW/SAHSS as a consortium to make digital resources and infrastructures for the humanities in Switzerland available.

Call for Posters

Make aware of your ongoing research by presenting a poster at the DARIAH-CH Study Day. We will have a dedicated spot on the USI campus for posters, and you will have the chance to pitch your poster before we move to the poster exhibition. We are looking for visual presentations as posters of Ph.D. and early career researchers as well as other people presenting their research.

Thanks to the sponsorship by the SAGW/SAHSS, we will award a prize for the best poster by a Ph.D. student, voted for by the participants. To be considered with a poster, apply until **July 15th, 2022**, by mail to Cristina Grisot, providing a short CV (one-page max.), an abstract of max. 250 words, including a title for your presentation. After the study day, the posters will be made available through the DARIAH-CH website.



The Scientific Committee will review all proposals. Mails of acceptance will be sent out by August 15th.
